

OYSP NON-COMPANY POLICIES 2020-21

COMMITMENT: It is important to understand that signing up for OYSP classes your financial commitment is for ONE SCHOOL YEAR SEASON (September-May). **In the event that we have to close and go to a zoom schedule due to Covid related concerns, you will be allowed to discontinue your classes and your monthly charge.** You must notify us of this in writing via email. However as long as regular, in-person options are still being offered, your commitment will still be for the full season. The only other exceptions are if your family moves out of the city/state or if your child is injured and unable to continue. In that event, the directors should also be notified immediately in writing at oconeeyouth@gmail.com.

TUITION: Tuition rates are broken down into 9 payments from September-May with May 2020 (last month) due in advance at the time of registration along with a one-time registration fee of \$35 per student. Tuition is not pro-rated for any reason. All closings/holidays are taken into account up front. Tuition rates are posted on the registration page on our website: oconeeyouth.com/registration

PAYMENTS:

Tuition is broken down into (9) payments and must be paid by automatic credit card payments. In person, monthly payments by cash or check are not accepted. All payments will now be made with our automatic pre-authorized credit card program online. Credit cards will be charged on the 1st of each month.

All fees are non-refundable and non transferable. Please be diligent in keeping your credit card information updated online as a \$25 late fee will be charged after the 10th for every month an account carries a balance. **ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE PAID IN FULL IN ORDER FOR STUDENTS TO RECEIVE COSTUMES AND PERFORM IN THE END OF THE YEAR RECITAL.**

DISCOUNTS: There is a 10% sibling discount on tuition for families with two or more children enrolled.

SPRING SHOWCASE & COSTUMES

The Spring Showcase dates for 2021 takes place at our home theater on site, Oconee Youth Theater. All students are expected to participate with the exception of voice/piano students and any acting classes, if applicable.

The dates for the 2021 Spring Showcase are as follows:

Saturday, May 8th (All Broadway Babies, Pre-K & K classes)

Thursday-Friday-Saturday-Sunday, May 13-16th (All classes 1st grade and up)

NOTE for 1st grade and up: Even though the Spring Showcase has 4 total performances, most classes will just perform on (2) of those dates.

There will be a \$25 recital fee per child posted/paid on November 15th. This fee helps cover all the extra work/time and energy for all the teachers involved in creating and carrying out the Spring Showcase (recital). They are many extra hours that go into making the show possible! Costume fees will also be posted/paid at this time at \$65 per costume per class. Tights are your responsibility. We will let you know the exact color/brand during costume distribution. Your child must have the exact style/color of shoes designated for your child's class and can be purchased or ordered at the studio during Open House or at DanceStyle in Athens.

DRESS CODE

BROADWAY BABIES/PRE-K/K: Pink or black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes. GIRLS: hair in a bun with a net. Please no skirts or anything extraneous like jewelry that might distract a young dancer.

BALLET: Solid leotard, pink ballet shoes, pink tights. Chiffon ballet skirts only. GIRLS: Hair in a bun with hair net. BOYS: Tank top with black jazz pants and black ballet shoes.

JAZZ/TAP: Leotard, tan tights, dance shorts or jazz pants. GIRLS: Hair secured in a ponytail. BOYS: Tank top with black jazz pants and jazz/tap shoes.

MUSICAL THEATER: Comfortable street clothes and jazz shoes

HIP HOP: Casual dance attire and jazz sneakers.

GENERAL OYSP POLICIES

IN-CLASS: Students are expected to attend class regularly, dress appropriately and be respectful of their teachers and fellow students.

Students will not be allowed to wait outside of the building for their ride. Please do not leave your car running unattended at the curb.

STUDIO PROCEDURES: Students are to remain in the kids' room in between classes. No running or yelling in the hallways. No food or drink is allowed in the studios. There is a designated eating area in the kids room for students who need to eat between classes.
